Allegheny County Sewer Authority (ALCOSAN) has started a \$2 billion expansion project to reduce the amount of system sewage overflows by 7 billion gallons annually. System upgrades expand ALCOSAN's capability to capture and treat excess water flow during heavy rainstorms.

Join us for a **FREE** informational webinar about the upcoming Ohio River Tunnel project. The anticipated tunnel size is over 150+ feet deep, 4.9 miles and between 14 and 18 feet in diameter. The solicitation release is planned for the summer of 2024 with a construction timeframe between 2025-2029.
