Graduate School POLICY: Honors at Graduation

A. Purpose & Scope

To describe the process and procedures for recognition of graduate students at Graduation.

B. Definition(s)

C. Policy

Honors at Graduation – At Commencement, graduate students who have earned a cumulative minimum 3.95 GPA in their degree program, based on their GPA in the term prior to graduation, are eligible to wear honors cords. In addition, graduate students must earn at least 50% of their degree program as graded Cal U courses in order to qualify with Honors at Graduation (Pass/Fail courses do not count toward the 50%). Graduate degree students earning honors at graduation are not acknowledged in the Commencement program and honors designations are not listed on graduate level diplomas or transcripts.
